Beautiful sound

AZUMI transverse flutes benefit from the experience of the ALTUS manufactory, especially with regard to the headjoint design and the cut of the lip-plate. The full-bodied sound of an AZUMI flute is particularly impressive with its brilliant, clear and assertive highs, carrying mids and sonorous lows. This makes playing the flute fun!

Learning success

The flutes in the AZUMI Z series are particularly popular with flute students due to their easy response and simple focussing. The quick learning success, that is possible with these instruments, is fun and motivating.

There is the right model for every student level, be it with a silver lip-plate, silver headjoint or a silver body flute.

Tonal variety

Advanced flutists with high demands on sound and design will find excellent models in the AZUMI S series, i.e. for playing successfully in an orchestra, chamber music ensemble or as a soloist.

Handmade ALTUS headjoints

More than 50 % of the sound is produced in the headjoint of a transverse flute. This fact inspired AZUMI founder Shuichi Tanaka to combine a handmade ALTUS headjoint with a high-quality flute body, accessible to beginners and advanced players.

This is how Tanaka created the AZUMI flute series, which fulfill the requirements of beginners and advanced musicians with ideal playing characteristics.

In the Z series you will find the typical, popular Sterling silver (92.5 % silver content) in combination with the Z-Cut lip-plate design for a quick and easy response. The S series uses the exclusive Britannia silver (95.8 % silver content), whereby the S-Cut lip-plate design offers a higher blowing resistance and more complex sound colours.





Shuichi Tanaka is one of the most extraordinary flute makers from the Japanese tradition. AZUMI offers particularly pleasant-sounding ALTUS headjoints made of the typical materials like nickel silver, Sterling silver and Britannia silver, which allow players to emphasise individual sound ideas.

Uniqueness

The headjoint and the corresponding body form a tonal unit and produce the outstanding sound of the AZUMI flutes. Learning to play the flute is therefore a great pleasure and enables rapid pro-

gress.

The material and design of the headjoint are fundamental to the sound and character of a flute. This is how the AZUMI Z and S series were created, which fulfill the requirements of both beginners and advanced musicians for learning the flute with ideal playing capacities.

The handcrafted headjoints are the result of passionate instrument making and dedication to precise craftsmanship. AZUMI benefits from the experience and knowledge of the Japanese manufacturer of transverse flutes - ALTUS.

With the two series, AZUMI offers a wide range of tonal possibilities, which is due to the use of different designs of the lip-plates and the silver alloys.



- Easy response, powerful sound and easy focussing of the tone.
- Headjoint: ALTUS Handmade Z-Cut with silver-plated body made of nickel silver (in the Z1 and Z2 series), or Sterling silver (925) (in the Z2 and Z3 series), recognisable by the square shape of the shape of the lipplate hole.
- Tuning: A = 442 Hz






